## Holly the Unicorn Crochet Pattern

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## Pattern Details

## Size:

16 inches from bottom of feet to top of head with weight 4 yarn and a 3.25 mm hook

## Skill Level Needed:

Intermediate- suitable for novice crocheters, requires patience and precisions when assembling the unicorn and basic crochet skills.

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## Materials Needed:

Red Heart Light Blue, Red Heart White, Red Heart Retro Stripe
Hook Size: D Hook or 3.25 mm
15 mm safety eyes
Scissors, sewing needle, stitch marker, fiberfill stuffing Blush(optional), black embroidery thread

## Abbreviations:

$\mathrm{mr}=$ magic ring- crochet single crochet stitches in to the adjustable loop
ch= chain stitch
BLO= back loops only
sc= single crochet stitch inc3= 3 sc in the same stitch $\mathrm{F} / \mathrm{O}=$ Fasten off

sl= slip stitch
dc= double crochet stitch
inc= increase- make two single crochet stitches in the same stitch dec=decrease- crochet two stitches together using the decrease method ( 4 sc , inc) $\times 6=$ repeat the pattern between parentheses 6 times

## Notes:

- Do not join rounds unless stated, work in a continuous spiral
- Use a stitch marker to mark the beginning of each round
- All stitches are worked in both loops unless stated otherwise in the pattern


## Head:

Crocheted from top of head to bottom With blue yarn

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring $=6$
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x $6=18$
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=24$
5. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=30$
6. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=36$
7. $(5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=42$
8. $(6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=48$
9. $(7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=54$
10. $(8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=60$

11-22. sc in each st around
Place eyes between rows 16 and 17, leaving 13 Holes between them
23. ( $8 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=54$
24. ( $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=48$

Start stuffing the head
25. ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x $6=42$
26. ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=36$
27. ( $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=30$
28. ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=24$
29. ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x 6= 18

F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

## Arms(Make 2):

Starting with white yarn

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring $=6$
2. Increase in each st around $=12$
3. (sc, inc) $\times 6=18$
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=24$
$5-6$. Sc in each st around
Change to blue yarn
5. ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 3=21$

8 -10. Sc in each st around
11. ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 3=18$
$12-13$. Sc in each st around Start stuffing the arms
14. ( $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 3=15$
$15-16$. Sc in each st around
17.13 sc , dec= 14

18-19. Sc in each st around
20. 12 sc , dec= 13

21-22. Sc in each st around
23. 11 sc , dec= 12

24-28. Sc in each st around
Stop stuffing the arms after row 26
29. ( $4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 2=10$
$30-31$. Sc in each st around
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

## Legs and Body:

Starting with the legs(Make 2)
Starting with white yarn

1. ( $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ ) $\times 2$ into a magic ring $=6$
2. Increase in each st around $=12$
3. ( sc, inc) $\times 6=18$
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=24$
5. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=30$
6. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=36$
$7-10$. sc in each st around
Change to blue yarn
7. 9 sc, dec $\times 6,15 \mathrm{sc}=30$
8. 7 sc , dec $\times 5,10 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}, \mathrm{sc}=24$
9. 2 sc , dec, 11 sc , dec, 4 sc , dec, sc= 21

14-15. sc in each st around
16. ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}$ ) $\times 3=24$

17-18. sc in each st around
Start stuffing the legs
19. (11 sc, inc) $\times 2=26$

20-21. sc in each st around
F/O first leg but not the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{leg}$
For the $2^{\text {nd }}$ leg on row 21 instead of making 26 sc,
Make only 21 sc. Leave the rest unworked.
Now to start the body
Connect the legs with a single crochet.
Follow the pictures below for better understanding
22. sc around the legs= 52
23. $(12 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 4=56$
24. $(13 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 4=60$

25-32. Sc in each st around 33. $(28 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2=58$

34-35. Sc in each st around
36. ( $27 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 2=56$

Stuff the body as you work 37-38. Sc in each st around 39. $(26 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}) \times 2=54$
$40-41$. Sc in each st around 42. ( $7 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=48$
$43-44$. Sc in each st around
45. ( $6 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=42$
$46-47$. Sc in each st around 48. ( $5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) $\times 6=36$

49-50. Sc in each st around
51. (4 sc, dec) x 6= 30

52-53. Sc in each st around
54. ( $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x $6=24$

55-56. Sc in each st around
57. ( $2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{dec}$ ) x $6=18$

F/O and leave a long tail for sewing



## Ears(Make 2):

With blue yarn

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring $=6$
2. (sc, inc) $\times 3=9$
3. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 3=12$
4. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 3=15$
5. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 3=18$

6 -9. sc in each st around
10. (sc, dec) x 6=12
11. $\operatorname{dec} \times 6=6$

F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

## Muzzle:

With blue yarn

1. Make 6 sc into a magic ring $=6$
2. Increase in each st around= 12
3. (sc, inc) x $6=18$
4. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=24$
5. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 6=30$
6. (4 sc, inc) x 6=36
$7-9$. Sc in each st around
7. (4 sc, dec) x 6=30

F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

## Horn:

With white yarn
Stuff the horn as you work

1. Make 4 sc into a magic ring $=4$
2. sc in each st around
3. (sc, inc) $\times 2=6$
4. sc in each st around
5. $(2 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2=8$
6. sc in each st around
7. $(3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2=10$
8. sc in each st around
9. $(4 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2=12$
10. sc in each st around
11. $(5 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{inc}) \times 2=14$

12-13. sc in each st around
F/O and leave a long tail for sewing

## Hair:

Front Mane:
With retro stripe
Chain 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across.
Do not fasten off, keep working off the $1^{\text {st }}$ chain
Chain 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across
Do not fasten off, keep working off the $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain
Repeat this process for each of the following numbers: 51, 46, 46, 46, 41, 41, 41
Back Make(Make 2):
With retro stripe
Ch 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across. Do not fasten off, keep working off that chain.
Ch 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across. Do not fasten off, keep working off that chain.
Repeat this process for each of the following numbers: 51, 46, 46, 46, 41, 41, 41
Tail:
With retro stripe
Chain 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across. Do not fasten off, keep working off that chain. Chain 51, sl st in $2^{\text {nd }}$ chain from hook and across. Do not fasten off, keep working off that chain. Repeat this process for each of the following numbers: $51,56,56,56,51,51,51,56,56,56,51$, 51, 51.


## Assembly

## Head and Body:

1. Pin the head onto the body for extra support. You may need to add more stuffing as you sew.
2. sew the head onto the body.


Arms:

1. Pin the arms into a forward angle on the side of the body underneath the neck. There are no certain row placements as I just try to decide based on look where the arms should go.
2. Sew them onto the body.

Tip! Closing the seam by crocheting over the opening will make sewing it to the body easier. Also the arms will lay nicely flat, instead of sticking out.


## Ears and Horn:

1. Pin the horn onto the head. Sew it on. There is no special row placement for this. I just try to judge based on look.
2. Pin the ears near the horn above the eyes. There is no special row placement for the ears since these are handmade. Not every head comes out stuffed the same. I place them based on the look I want.


Hair:

1. Have the eyes facing you. Pin the mane starting behind the horn going down the side on the left side of the head. Sew it on the head.
2. Pin one back mane piece on the head starting from the horn and going down the back of the head. Place it exactly like a real horse's mane. Sew this one on. Pin the $2^{\text {nd }}$ back mane piece underneath the $1^{\text {st }}$ one and sew on like the first.
3. Wrap the tail into a circle and sew the top together. Pin onto the back of the body and sew it in place. Just like a real horse's tail.
